Coach Don Rekoske is in his 23rd season as a coach. He has been a head coach at both the high school and college levels.



He has been head coach at Bryan College for the past 6 years. This year's team finished 18-10 with a share of conference title. The team was top five nationally in NAIA in scoring defense, field goal percentage defense and rebounding margin. They also received an All-American Academic Award with a 3.1 team GPA and were voted by the conference coaches as the Champions of Character for this year.

Coach Rekoske has worked camps throughout the country including the Universities of Michigan, Iowa, Wisconsin, Northern Iowa, and Minnesota, and has run camps in 7 states.

This years camp stresses individual player development and offensive fundamentals of the game.

CAMP EMPHASIS

There will be a strong emphasis on shooting. Specific tools will be used to correct shooting form, and drills will reinforce the changes implemented. Individual offensive moves in the open court and in the half court will be introduced and worked on in a station format.
