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CAMP DIRECTOR/CLINICIAN

Bryan College Head Volleyball Coach **David Shumaker** brings over 20 years of coaching experience to Bryan College Volleyball Camps. In his previous coaching position, he led his team to 4 straight NCCAA East Region Championships, including a 2nd-place finish in the National Tournament, and a 29-11 record in 2005. He garnered numerous honors in the NCCAA, receiving 3 Regional Coach of the Year awards, while being named National Coach of the Year in 2003. After transitioning the team to the NCAA III, Coach Shumaker led his team to 2 straight NCAA conference championships in the North Eastern Athletic Conference (NEAC). Under his leadership, the 2006 volleyball team became the school's first ever team to qualify for the NCAA III National Tournament. After his team moved to the Colonial States Athletic Conference, they ranked in the top three every year finishing the 2010 season as conference runner-up. Coach Shumaker received the NEAC Volleyball Coach of the Year award in 2005 and 2006, and was named the CSAC Coach of the Year in 2010. In his first season at Bryan College he led his team to an 11-3 conference record, finishing second place in the conference.

Coach Shumaker's teams are known for their tenacious defense and aggressive, multi-tempo offense. Athletes will train in fundamental volleyball skills in the context of fun, game-like drills.

Your athlete will be trained by Coach Shumaker, Bryan College staff, alumni, and players—both past and present.
